## *How to get here!*

**The Woodland Festival takes place at Thoresby Park, NG22 9EP, on Saturday 25 & Sunday 26 July, from 10am–4pm.**

Whether you're travelling by car, bike or public transport, here's everything you need to know before you set off.

### **By Car**

Thoresby Park is easily accessible from the A614 and is well signposted from nearby towns including Ollerton, Edwinstowe, Mansfield and Worksop. Parking is available on site.

### **Car Parking**

Car parking for the Woodland Festival is £9 per vehicle.

We know this is an increase from previous years, so we'd like to explain why.

A proportion of every parking ticket comes directly to Sherwood Forest Trust and helps us cover the cost of putting on this free community event. Your parking fee helps pay for essentials such as toilets, first aid, security and event infrastructure. Most importantly, it helps us provide the huge range of entertainment, activities, demonstrations and workshops that are free for everyone to enjoy once you're through the gates.

Every parking ticket helps us keep the Woodland Festival free to enter and accessible to as many people as possible.

### **By Public Transport**

There are currently no regular bus services directly to Thoresby Park.

However, you can use Nottsbus On Demand, a flexible bookable bus service that operates across the area and can take you to Thoresby Park from locations within its travel zones. Journeys can be booked through the app or by phone, making it a great option if you're travelling without a car.

### **By Bike**

Why not make a day of it and cycle to the festival?

There are a number of quiet country lanes and popular cycling routes leading to Thoresby Park from surrounding villages and towns, with plenty of beautiful Sherwood scenery along the way.
